

Detective investigation worksheet

A fun exercise in carrying out primary research for children aged 5 and over. If you don't know where to start, some example answers have been given in grey.

1. I want to research...

Write down your detective mission (find out which film is most popular with your friends)

2. Why?

Write down your reason for investigating this now (because I'd like to find some good new films to watch)

3. What?

What do you need to know? (which films have my friends watched? Did they like them?)

4. Who?

Who do you need to talk to? (10 of my friends, a mix of boys and girls aged 6-7)

5. How?

What's the best way to talk to them? Why? (sending a survey to their parents so I can collect and look at answers easily.)
